

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capability. Hook type fork carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the tine eye. Different makers will vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
