Since they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are a lot less susceptible to damage. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are fifty percent. This extra space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like for example elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.
