1. Fold-away Floor Scrubbers

2. Mains & Battery Operated

The battery operated version is best suited for small places like for example washrooms with hard to reach parts which would be hard to clean with a trailing power lead. The battery could be charged and used for around 4 hours prior to re-charging is required. The battery can also be replaced if needed.

3. Walking or Ride-on devices

The ride-on machine is a great alternative if the floor scrubber you require is for large spaces like for instance inside of warehouses or retail interiors. This version allows the worker to steer the machine all-around obstructions and corners efficiently and easily as the driver has a good vantage point. These types of floor scrubbing equipment come equipped with a two hundred fifty liter water tank and an equivalent container to collect the filthy water. Walking machines are similar models that can be operated by someone walking at the rear of the machine and steering the scrubber.

4. Robotic Floor Scrubber devices

A robot floor scrubber may be one more option to think about. These versions are ideal if you require a high specification floor scrubber to clean a large location that has minimum obstacles. These models have sensors installed to allow the equipment the ability to steer clear of walls, stairs, humans and doors.
