Forklift Carriage

Forklift Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is more or less thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
